## Complimentary Online Store Research

Are you an academic law librarian with student or professor patrons who might benefit from California legislative history research? LRI's newly launched Online Store research is available to them at no charge.

Legislative Research & Intent LLC (LRI) has launched a unique Online Store for California legislative history at [www.lrihistory.com](http://www.lrihistory.com). All regular session bills that passed are covered from 1943 –2010 (recently augmented from 1943–2006). Selected bills are covered from 2011 to current. This rich collection consists of materials from LRI's expansive, precompiled digital library, and other files from public sources that are added daily. Normally, attorneys and other researchers can search this database and purchase materials for \$50–\$275.

***LRI is now making this collection available for orders processed through academic law librarians, with certain restrictions.*** The free materials are only available to currently enrolled law school students and law school professors for the uses specified below. They are not available for non-law school patrons or if the requestor is receiving outside (non-law school) compensation. Please refer such requestors to the LRI web site at [www.lrihistory.com](http://www.lrihistory.com) if they would like to purchase legislative history materials.

***Instructions.*** There are four categories of accepted use for law school students and law school professors: (1) law review articles, (2) pro bono or clinical projects, (3) research papers, and (4) talks and lectures. Below are the forms applicable to each category. After your requestor fills out the appropriate form and signs it, please email the PDF to Carolina Rose at [carolina.rose@lrihistory.com](mailto:carolina.rose@lrihistory.com). (Be sure to call her at 916.442.7660 to make certain it did not get caught up in her SPAM folder.) LRI will then email the requestor a one-time, temporary password to download the materials at no cost.
